

**Excerpt from article four of
the Healthy Living, Inc. Articles of Incorporation**

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, but not limited to:

- (1) educating the general public about adopting environmentally conscious and sustainable lifestyles through such avenues as healthy eating, healthy lifestyles, and conservation, and preserving the environment;
- (2) collaborating with researchers, educators and other individuals and organizations interested in adopting environmentally conscious and sustainable lifestyles through such avenues as healthy eating, healthy lifestyles, and conservation;
- (3) conducting seminars, conferences, classes and other such educational events which teach philosophies, technologies and practical skills to adopt environmentally conscious and sustainable lifestyles;
- (4) teaching macrobiotic cooking, as well as vegetarian and vegan cooking;
- (5) creating public and celebratory events which further the art of organic cooking as a cultural tool;
- (6) provide consulting and educational services with respect to any of the above;
- (7) publishing and distributing magazines, books, films, videocassettes, audiocassettes, computer programs, websites, newsletters, and other literature, programming, electronic media, and computer generated material for the above-mentioned educational purposes;
- (8) promoting cultural culinary exchanges between countries, especially Europe;
- (9) providing meals and catering services as a tool for the above-mentioned educational purposes;

(10) providing charitable services both nationally and internationally where need arises; and

(11) making grants or otherwise distribute funds to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations pursuant to IRC Section 501 (c) (3) as amended from time to time.

(12) performing any other activities or services necessary or convenient to carry out such purposes, to the extent permitted by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law).
